Item 1st I give my Daughter Marianne Gibney an (illegitimate) child born to me by Catharine Gibney her mother one equal moiety of my ferry at the mouth of Green creek and the premises in any wise appertaining thereto

23 either by renting or sale which money will be appropriated by my brother Lewis Sublett for her raising and Education the care of which is to devolve on him the said Lewis Sublett he and she come of age then the remaining part of her half to be given her Item 2nd I give John Sublett son of William Sublett and Lewis Sublett son of James Sublett one hundred dollars each on their becoming of age Item 3rd I give my sister Frances Vaughn thirty dollars which I desire she may appropriate to the use of purchasing a gold ornament or locket money to be given her immediately on my deceased Item 4th I give my brother Lewis Sublett one half the other equal moiety or half of my said ferry and premises appertaining thereto together with all my personal property goods and chattels after paying my just debts and the legates above mentioned out of the proceeds of his part or half Item 5th I do hereby appoint my brother Lewis Sublett my true and lawful Executor to do and act in strict conformity with this my last will and testament. It is my wish that Abraham Sublett should have my little spanish horse given under my hand and seal date above written In the presence of Francis Lockett Lewis Sublett } John J Sublett (Sd)
