Rich^d Sonny, of the County of Woodford and State of Kentucky do make and Ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following to wit I give to my beloved wife Mary eight negroes namely Anthony, Mary, Fortune and her boy child Daniel, Humphrey, Charles, Cassa, and Giles during her natural life also the houses and farms where I now live all the lands on the North Side of Steels road also the Still house lot and hay meadow supposed to contain a hundred and twenty acres also one equal half of all my household and kitchen furniture one equal half of all my stock of every kind and farming utensils now heretofore disposed off during her natural life after her death shall be disposed off as I shall hereafter direct. I give to my son merrett Sonny all my land the South Side of Steels road except the Still house lot and hay meadow supposed to contain 120 acres also four negroes (Bond) Anthony, Mary, Fortune and her boy Daniel after the death of my wife to him and his heirs forever, I give to my son in law Henry Lee two negroes Humphrey & Giles a good feather bed and furniture for which he is to deduct one hundred dollars out of the money I borrow from him when ever he receives the negroes, I give to my son in law John Slack two negroes Charles & Cassa after the death of my wife when ever he receives said negroes here to pay Henry Lee

One hundred dollars which I owe him. I give to my son in Law Amos two negroes George and Elora which he has in possession also 320 acres of land on the water of Licking also a good bed and furniture two cows and my old gray riding horse. I give to my son Richard Young a negro man named ^{Paul} Correll man during his natural and at his decease they are to return to me or my heir I also give to his wife Sarah my wife Correll man and Lido saddle during her natural and at her decease to be returned to me or my heir I give to my son A. G. Young and Correll colts called vanter also one equal half of all my house hold and kitchen furniture farming utensils and other stock not heretofore disposed of I give to my daughter Sam Johnson two negro girls that she has in possession also one hundred dollars to be paid her twelve months after my decease by Morrato Young in consequence of his having forborne and her child I give to my grand daughter Mary Ann Young 200 acres of land to be laid off in a square at the corner of a 1000 acre survey made in the name of John Craig on the water of Licking and divided to Richd Young.
