BAILLIE, George of Savannah deeds to his dau., Jourdainne Cunningham Baillie, spinster, 6/27/1775 1/2 part of moiety in St. George's Parish, 100 acres. Ga. Colonial Deed Bk DD, p. 286.

BAILLIE, Kenneth, Colonel m. after 1742 Elizabeth Mackay, dau. of John (b. 1679 Durnes, Scotland). Kenneth was b. 1715 Scotland, d. 1766 Sunbury, Liberty Co., Ga. He left Scotland 10/29/1735, arrived in Ga. 1/10/1736, was an Ensign to the Darien Co. He was taken by the Spaniards at Ft. Moosa from which he ultimately escaped to England 1/1742, returning to Ga. 3/1742. Baillie was a planter of a rice plantation in Liberty Co., also owned timber lands and two town lots in Sunbury, Ga., as well as over 1000 acres on St. Mary's Island where his home stood, which he called "Baillie's Island", located on Medway River. in The Colonial Records of Georgia by Candler, Baillie states that Gen. Oglethorpe's plan to capture Augustine would have succeeded had it not been for the captains of the boats who did not capture Spanish vessels, which would have prevented the Spanish from coming into Augustine with guns and provisions. While in England, he reported on the cultural conditions of the soil and complaints from settlers for not being permitted to own negro slaves. Issue: Alexander m. Hester Jane (d. 3/13/1794), residents of their plantation in McIntosh Co., Ga. called "Laurel Hill"; Robert Garnibe m. Mary Ann McIntosh, the only sister to Gen. Lachlan McIntosh who d. 11/23/1803 at her home on Sapelo River in McIntosh Co.; lived on Island of Jamaica, but in 1742 petitioned for 1500 acres in Ga. on St. Simon's Island, adj. lands of Mark Carr; Surveyor for Midway Dist. in 1755; 1766 qualified as a Member of House of Governor's Council from St. Andrew's Parish; 1761 served in Gen. Assembly; took England's side during American Revolution for which he was declared a traitor in 1782 (Issue: Claudia d. 3/24/1806; Jane d. Riceboro, Ga. 4/17/1809); Jean m. Andrew Darling, a Merchant at Sunbury, Liberty Co.; Ann Elizabeth b. 7/27/1749 Liberty Co., Ga. d. 7/23/1807 Savannah, Ga. m. 9/19/1765 Dr. John Irvine, b. 9/15/1742 Drum, Scotland (SW of

Aberdeem) d. 10/15/1808 Savannah, Ga. (emigrant to America in 1764); Jane and Ann.

BASS, A. S., son of Milton. Memoirs of Georgia, p. 1027: "A. S. Bass, depot agent and storekeeper, Hancock Co. (d. 1883). Mr. Bass comes from good old Virginia stock, from which his grandfather, Edmund Bass, emigrated when in his teens. Mr. Bass' father married a Miss Ingram (d. 1869) and settled in western part of the county where he reared a family of four sons and five daughters. Milton, m. Ann Culver; Hardy C.; W. H.; Macon; A. S.; Carrie G. (wid. of J. W. Mote); George E. (d. Federal Prison during war); Wesley A.,"

BASS, Burwell, son of James and Betsy, was listed on the 1790 Greenville Co., Va. Census, 4 whites, 10 blacks. The name of his first wife is unknown, but he m. (2) Betsy Harper, 2/8/1810, Hancock Co., Ga., a dau. of Mary Harper who d. 3/1840 Hancock Co., Ga., leaving her LWT naming her grandchildren. Other bros. and sisters of Burwell Bass appear to be: Sterling Bass; Allen Bass; Esau Bass. Sterling Bass m. Elizabeth Dupree 5/23/1793 Greenville Co., Va. and bought land from John Day, 1805, Hancock Co., Ga. (Deed Bk F, p. 169). Allen Bass m. Elizabeth Davis (with Burwell Bass as surety on the bond) 9/30/1790, Greenville Co., Va. and bought land in Hancock Co., Ga. from A. Youngblood, 1806 (Deed Bk F, p. 43). Greenville Co., Va. Order Bk No. 1, p. 8: "The Courts Valuation of Property, impressed for the use of the public in Greenville County, Virginia during the latter period of the Revolutionary War, one gun, Burwell Bass, 5.15.7-1/2. March 12, 1782." "At a Court held for Greenville Co. on Thurs. the 22nd day of Nov. 1781, ... ordered that Burwell Bass, John Turner, John Powell and John Mackensee or any three of them, being first sworn to appraise in current money the estate of Aaron Park, decd, according to the law and return the said appraisement to the court." The Estate of Burwell Bass, May 1821, Hancock Co., Ga. Inv. dtd 6/1/1821 and account of sales dtd 7/2/1821, Hancock Co. (Bk L, p. 38), lists: "Edmund S. Bass, one coffee mill, Barthlo. Ingram, Sr., carryall, Edmund S. Bass, one raising plane and one compass saw." Issue of Burwell: Benjamin and Nancy.

BASS, Edmund S., son of James and Betsy Bass, was b. ca 1777 Greenville Co., Va., d. 5/1843 Hancock Co., Ga. m. Elizabeth H. Bass was still in Virginia in 1808, and in Hancock Co., Ga. by 1820. In 1824 he received a land grant of 9 acres in Hancock Co. He also drew in 1827 Hancock Co. Land Lottery, with other brothers, who were listed as "Orphans of Burwell Bass." LWT of Edmund S. Bass dtd 5/30/1842, Codicil 2/5/1843. Hancock Co., Ga. Wills, Book Q, p. 53. LWT submitted for probate by James, George W. and Milton Bass, exrs. Wife: Elizabeth H.
