CASTLEBERRY, Heinrich, spelled Kesselbery, migrated from Bachersdorf, Germany, near Bruges (Bruggen) to Germantown, Pa., landing there 10/5/1683. 3/7/1691 he made an attempt at Naturalization, which act was required before he could own land, being one of 62 applications. There arose a dispute concerning the legality of the procedure, whereupon, he and 25 others, had to be re-naturalized according to Pa. Statues at Large, Vol. II, p. 299, 9/29/1709. In 1692, he witnessed the marriage of Henry Ffrey and Anna Lovering, and signed his name as Heinrich Kasselbery, Acting Justice of the Peace.
