FEW, Ignatius A. first President of Emory College, was b. Columbia Co., Ga. 4/11/1789. His father, Capt. Ignatius Few, was a gallant soldier in the war for independence and the son was in the War of 1812. He graduated from Princeton College and when Emory was founded in 1837, he was elected the first president. He was a Methodist Minister, known all over Georgia, dying at Athens, Ga. 11/28/1845. After remaining at our winter quarters for a few days, resting and feeding up, we started on our long eastward journey, leaving the wounded and sick in charge of Dr. I. K. Frazer...."
