War Soldier while res. of Culpepper Co., Va., Pvt., Va. Troops. Res. Culpepper Co. until 1794 when he removed to Jessamine Co., Ky. 1/24/1844 his widow was allowed pension. She d. 2/10/1845/8 Laurel Co., Ky. McCalls Roster of the Revolution.

GATES, Charles listed on 1790 and 1800 Pendleton Dist., S. C. Census. Philip Gates and Charles Gates were in 1805 Ga. Land Lottery. Charles, Jr. drew in 1827 Gwinnett Co. Land Lottery. Charles, Sr., a Rev. War Soldier, drew land in 1832 Cherokee Co. Land Lottery (granted 1833). Gone to Georgia.

GATES, Elijah, Dr. was an early pioneer physician in Newberry Dist., S. C.

GILBERT, Joseph Bertie Co., N. C. Land Grant 3/29/1860, 176 acres in Shaftsbury Precinct on MS of Mattcom Creek. Bertie Co. Deed Book I, p. 144. Also, 10/9/1712, 150 acres at head of Thomas Hoskins' land. Book I, p. 211.

GILBERT, Josiah, son of Thomas, was b. 2/17/1717 at Springfield, Mass, and moved to N. C. with another relative, Jonathan Gilbert (d. Bertie Co.) and d. Perquimans Co., N. C. in 1760. He m. (10 Mary Goss (2) Sarah. Issue: Rev. Thomas Gilbert.

GODFREY, John, his LWT Bartholomew Parish, S. C. He was son of Richard, planter. Bro: William. Sister: Elizabeth Fando. Exrs: William Godfrey, Dr. William Webb, Charles Lining, Peter Myrne. 4/3/1790, probated 12/18/1790, Charleston Co., S. C. Wills Vol. 23, p. 745-6.

GOFORTH, Ezekiel, son of Miles, 1766-1850 m. Sarah Clements Goforth, widow of John Goforth, son of Preston Goforth. The youngest son of William Goforth, Jr. and Sarah Preston Goforth. Sarah Clements was b. Augusta, Ga. 1766 d. 1842 Buncombe Co., N. C. Ezekiel and Sarah buried old Payne Cemetery, 10-12 miles W of Marshall, N. C. Issue of Ezekiel and Sarah: Isaac ca 1787-1870 d. Tenn.; George 1791-1885 of Madison Co., N. C.; Ezekiel, Jr. d. Blount Co., Tenn.; and Miles b. 1800 m. Elizabeth Patillo (she d. Hedderston Co., N. C. ca 1846. Miles and Elizabeth had: Martha b. 1826 m. W. H. Davis; Millington; John L.; Sarah; Rebecca m. Marion Jackson 1850; Albert; Mary; Miles A. Ref: Herndon W. Goforth, Lenoir, N. C. letter dtd 4/29/1957.
