I have attached a report of the Cole/Haselwood family, which includes the will of Mary COLE, naming her two CATLETT grandsons by her daughter, Francis. I have also attached the information we have on Hazelwood CATLETT, my descendant through his son, Laban. Lastly, I have attached a working document which specifies some of my research on the Haselwood family, which became my target. Some of it is duplicated in the first attachment, and some is not.

I look forward to working with you and understand that there are no promises. When I first began researching CATLETT a year ago, I never knew there were so many (bet you've heard that before).

Dear Pam -

I have worked several days on your Catlett genealogy, both in Virginia and in North Carolina, with just practically no results.

I agree that it is imminent to find the children of Thomas and William Catlett, sons of Frances Haselwood and Thomas Catlett.

Bute Co. was once part of Granville Co., and I searched all of Granville Co., finding nothing. When Bute Co. was abolished in 1779, it became Franklin Co.

Apparently Hazlewood lived in that part of Bute Co. which I later became Franklin Co. It appears that Hazlewood Catlett was in Bute Co., NC as early as 1769 according to the Minutes of May 12th...."Ordered that a road be cleared according to a petition first for a view of a jury from Granville line across to Johnson."

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I assume that you have seen the Catlett book at the Archives (under Baytop) which details the family from England to Essex and Rappahannock Co.'s, Va. This genealogy does not deal with the above Thomas or William. This branch of the family did not leave a Will in Virginia, or North Carolina.

I searched Johnston, Randolph, Bute and Granville Co.'s, N. C., as well as Middlesex, Frederick, Caroline and Orange Co.'s, VA.

County....Ordered that Hazelwood Catlett, etc., view the most convient way for the road..."

Again, a Bute Co. deed dated 8/9/1774 from Hasilwood Catlett to Osborn Jeffrey, Esq. was proved by the oath of Stephen Lowe, a witness thereto and on motion the same was ordered to be registered.

North Carolina Taxpayers:

Hazelwood Cattlett - Bute Co., 1771
John Cattlett - Randolph Co., 1779

Of course the 1790 Franklin Co., NC Census, Halifax District, lists Laborne Catlett.

Because of the lack of more complete records at the Georgia Archives, I don't feel that I can help you. I thought that if I could locate a NC land grant, or deed transaction for a William or Thomas Catlett, this would point to the father. However, no evidence was found. Hazlewood in 1764 must have been around 20 or 30 ... he may have migrated into NC without his parents.

Also, I searched for bible records, nothing there. There was a Thomas Catlett who received 66 acres in Goochland Co. 9/28/1732.

The reason I took so long on this, is trying to find "something". Perhaps the NC and VA State Archives is the next stop.

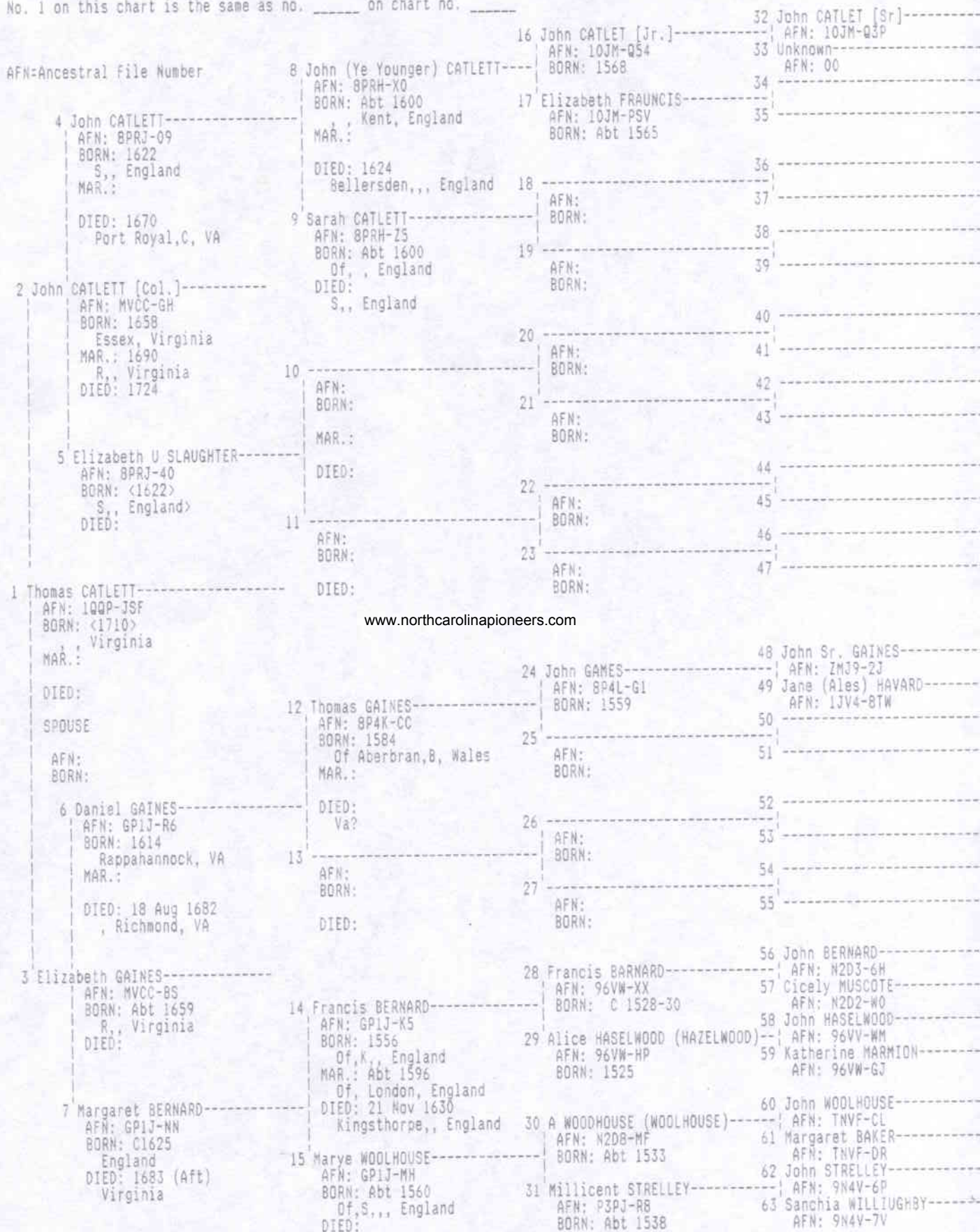
