K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Ansell Jackson*

have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Ansell Jackson*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred

Acres, lying and being in our County of

Bladen

*On the South side of Drowning Creek and both
Sides of Turkey Branch Beginning at a Line
about Seventy Yards North of said Branch about
300 Yards below John Jacksons Improvements
Running North East to a Stake among two
Pines Pointers then West One hundred and
Twenty seven Poles to a Stake among 3 Pine
Pointers then South One hundred and Twenty
Seven Poles to a Stake then South to the Beginning
as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said*

Ansell Jackson his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Ansell Jackson*

shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
