K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *Archibald Bone* have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Archibald Bone* a Tract of Land, containing

One Hundred Acres, lying and being in our County of

Bladen

On the Southside of Buckhorn Swamp near the Mouth and running down for Complements Beginning at a Black Gum in the edge of the Swamp and running South Twenty five West Thirty three Chains to a Black Stake on a Stake then South Sixty five East Thirty Chains and Thirty Links to a Pine, then North Twenty five East Thirty three Chains to a Stake, then North Sixty five West Thirty Chains and Thirty Links to the Beginning

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Archibald Bone his Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

Archibald Bone shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
