To all to whom these Presents shall
come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Archibald McKeen, Junr*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Archibald McKeen, Junr*
a Tract of Land, containing

(One hundred)
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*.

*On the West side of Downing Creek and on the East side of Ash Pole
Beginning at three White Oaks and a Black Oak said to be McKeen's,
thence corner a Station running North Sixty five degrees East thirty
Poles to a small Pine, then North Twenty five degrees West One
hundred and eighty Poles to a Stake and four Pines, then South
Sixty five degrees West Ninety Poles to a Large Pine, then South
Twenty five degrees East One hundred and eighty Poles to a Stake
thence North Sixty five degrees East thirty Poles to the first Station*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Archibald McKeen, Junr his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Archibald McKeen, Junr*
Junr shall cause this Grant to

be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
