K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Archibald McLain*

have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Archibald McLain*

a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

Bladen

*On the side of Downing Creek and on the West side of Wilkerson
Swamp Beginning at a Pine near his Survey Line running
South forty two West One hundred and Twenty seven Poles
to a Stake, then South forty five East One hundred and Twenty
seven Poles to a Stake, then North forty five East One hundred
and Twenty seven Poles to a Stake, then North forty two West
One hundred and Twenty seven Poles to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Archibald McLain his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Archibald McLain*

shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
