K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Charles Bulloch*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Charles Bulloch*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*Joining his own Land Beginning at a Poplar in a
Small Branch the Beginning of his own Land and
Running South fifty East ninety Pole to a Stake thence
North forty East One hundred and Eighty Poles to a
Stake and two Pines Point to thence North fifty Poles
thence South forty Poles to
his old Line along said Line is the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Charles Bulloch his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

Charles Bulloch shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
