

To all to whom these Presents shall
come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *Christopher Williams* have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Christopher Williams* a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred and Fifty Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*.

On both Sides of Crubb Creek (beginning) at Robert Broadways first corner Elman (Running) South forty four chains and Seventy five Links to a stake Between two White Oaks in Edward Travis line thence North thirty one Degrees West thirty three chains and fifty Links crossing of Crubb Creek to a stake Between two pines thence North forty four chains and Seventy five links to a pine in Broadways line thence with the said Broadways line South thirty Degrees East thirty three chains and fifty Links crossing of said Creek to the Beginning.

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Christopher Williams* his Heirs and

Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Christopher Williams* shall cause this Grant to

be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.

IN TESTIMONY whereof, we have caused our Great Seal to be hereunto affixed. WITNESS *RICHARD CASWELL*, Esquire, our Governor, Captain-General, and Commander in Chief, at *Kingston*, the *third* Day of *September* in the *fourth* Year of our Independence, and in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and *Twenty Nine*.
