K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *David Godwin*
have Given and Granted, and, by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *David Godwin*
a Tract of Land, containing

Fifty
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*On the South side of the Beavondam Swamp Beginning
on the Edge of the Swamp at a Red Oak near his
Improvement and Running South Sixty four Poles
to a Black Jack then East One hundred and Twenty
Eight Poles to a White Oak then North Sixty four Poles
to a Stake then West One hundred and Twenty eight
Poles to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

David Godwin his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *David Godwin*

shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
