Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *David Lloyd*

have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *David Lloyd*
a Tract of Land, containing

Two hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of

Bladen

*On the East side of Cape Fear River and South side of Gum
Swamps Beginning at a Large Pine near a Path goes from
Abraham Spears to Waddles Ferry Running North
Thirty West Two hundred and fifty three Poles to Granston
Land thence South Sixty West Two hundred and fifty
three Poles to a Stake, then South thirty East two hundred
and fifty three Poles to a Stake thence North Sixty East
Two hundred and fifty three Poles to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

David Lloyd his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

David Lloyd shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
