**K** NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of  
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid  
into our Treasury by David Mimms

have Given and Granted, and by these  
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said David Mimms

a Tract of Land, containing  
One hundred and fifty  
Acres, lying and being in our County of Bladen

On Palmetto Bay Beginning on the West side of the said  
Bay at a Pine Running D. East Thirty eight Chains  
to a small Pine, thence D. South thirty nine Chains, fifty  
Links to a Stake by Pine thence D. West thirty eight  
Chains to a Stake, thence D. South thirty nine Chains  
fifty Links to the Beginning corner

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,  
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the  
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

David Mimms his Heirs  
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money  
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may  
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

David Mimms shall cause this Grant to be  
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of Bladen  
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise  
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
