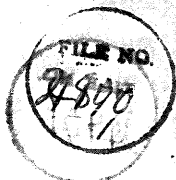


To all to whom these Presents shall
come, Greeting.



K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Dennis Dawson*

have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Dennis Dawson*

a Tract of Land, containing

Two hundred and fifty Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

On the East side of *Drowning Creek* Beginning at a Bay
Rack in a Large Bay at his old corner and Runs South
Seven to West One hundred and fifty five Pole to a small Pine
on the side of *Porters Swamp* then South Eastern West forty three
Pole to a gum in the Swamp then South Sixty East One hundred
and fifty four Pole to a small Pine then more Union corner then
South thirty two East One hundred and forty two Pole to a
Stake and then Pine then North fifty eight East two hundred
Pole to a Stake and then Pine then North thirty two West
One hundred and fifty four Pole to a Stake that is the Beginning
as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Dennis Dawson his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Dennis Dawson*

shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
