KNOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Dennis Lannon*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Dennis Lannon*
a Tract of Land, containing
Two hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

On the South West side of the North West River
Joining on the upper side of David Whites Land
Beginning at a Large Pine running North forty four
East two hundred and Twenty Poles to Harrison's
Land thence North forty six West two hundred and
Twenty Poles to a Stake then South forty four West
Two hundred and Twenty Poles to Dennis
Lannon's old Survey then South forty six East
two hundred and Twenty Poles to the Beginning

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Dennis Lannon his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

Dennis Lannon shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
