K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *Edward Harrison* have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Edward Harrison* a Tract of Land, containing *One hundred* Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

On the East side of Drowning Branch and on the Lower side of Sugar Branch and West side of the Great Swamp. Beginning near said Swamp at a Large Pine and Running North thirty five degrees West One hundred and Twenty Seven Poles to a Stake and thence thence North fifty five degrees East One hundred and Twenty Seven Poles to a Stake in the Great Swamp. Then South thirty five degrees East One hundred and Twenty Seven Poles to a Stake. Then South fifty five degrees West One hundred and Twenty Seven Poles to the Beginning.

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Edward Harrison his Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Edward Harrison* shall cause this Grant to

be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
