K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Edward Willson*

have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Edward Willson*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*On the East side of Jones Swamp on the Blue
Ponds Beginning at a pine and Running N. North One
hundred and Sixty six Poles to a Stake by Large pond
to the Bay Line thence on the said Line South East
East One hundred and Twenty Poles to a pine S. South
One hundred and fifty two Poles to a Stake thence North
Eighty three poles West One hundred and sixteen
Poles to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Edward Willson his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

Edward Willson shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
