come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Elias Barnes*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Elias Barnes*
a Tract of Land, containing

Two hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*West of Downing Creek on both sides of Old Field
Swamp beginning at a small Pine near Abraham
Barnes's Vine turning South fifty West One hundred
and Twenty seven Poles to a small Pine thence North
Forty West two hundred and fifty three Poles to a Stake
and three Pines thence North fifty East One hundred
and Twenty seven Poles to a Large Pine thence South
forty East two hundred and fifty three Poles to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Elias Barnes his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

Elias Barnes shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
