come, Greeting.*

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *Elizabeth Brooks*, have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Elizabeth Brooks*, a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred and thirty Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*.

*South West of Pee Dee on the Watery Branch of West
fields Creek Beginning at Joseph Person's third Corner a
pine then with his line North thirty six Chains and
Ten Links to a stake amongst four pines then West
thirty six Chains and Ten Links to a poplar and two
Pines standing in the Swamp of the Watery branch
then South thirty six Chains and Ten Links to a
Corner then East thirty six Chains and ten Links
to the Beginning.*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Elizabeth Brooks*

Brooks her Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Elizabeth Brooks*

shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
