

To all to whom these Presents shall
come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Ephraim Mulford*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Ephraim Mulford*
a Tract of Land, containing
Three hundred and Twenty
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*.

*On the North side of Longleaves Lake and on the South West side
of Colley Beginning at a pine at Thomas Rife's corner
and running South forty five degrees East Eighty chains to a
stake by dead pine, then North forty five degrees East forty chains
to a stake in Colley, thence up Colley North forty five degrees
West Eighty chains to a stake in Colley, then South forty
five West forty chains to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Ephraim Mulford his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Ephraim Mulford*

shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
