K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Ezekiel Burbey*

have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Ezekiel Burbey*

a Tract of Land, containing

Two hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of

Bladen

*Lying Between Arentons Land and my own Land
Beginning at said Burbeys Lower Corner and running
along this Line South thirty one West seventy two Pole
to George Browns Line. Then North fifty nine West
seventy four Pole to a Stake, then North thirty one East One
hundred and fifty four Pole to a Stake, then South
fifty nine East three hundred and thirty Poles to a Stake
thence South thirty one West Eighty two Pole to a Stake
then North fifty nine West two hundred and fifty six Pole
to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Ezekiel Burbey his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
