come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Frederick Semple*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Frederick Semple*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *ANSON* -

South West of P. D. Dean Patts Branch of Jones Creek -
Beginning at a point in James Plunketts Line then with the
Course of his marked Tree South five West Forty Chams -
Running by Plunketts Corner to a Stake amongst three Black
Jacks then North Eighty five West thirty Chams to a stake
and three Black Jacks then North five East Sixteen Chams
and fifty links to a Stake amongst two pines near to George
Soudon Budds Lines then North forty seven East forty six
Chams to a corner then South five West Eleven Chams to
the Beginning.

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Frederick*
Semple his Heirs and

Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Frederick Semple*
shall cause this Grant to

be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
