come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *George Briley*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *George Briley*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*

*South West of Pee Dee on Smiths Creek Beginning at
a Hickory on the N. West of said Creek Running thence
South Twenty East thirty one Chains and Sixty three
Links to a stake post Oak Hickory and Red Oak
then South Twenty West thirty one Chains Sixty three
Links to a stake four Hickories and Pine then North
twenty West thirty one Chains and Sixty three links
to a stake three Hickories and Pine then North Twenty
East thirty one Chains and Sixty three Links to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *George*

Briley his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *George Briley*

shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
