

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting.

**K**NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *George Jefferson* -

Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *George Jefferson* - have Given and Granted, and by these

a Tract of Land, containing

Three Hundred

Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*

North East of Bee Bee Beginning at William Newby's corner White Oak on the hill side near a small Branch and Running with the same line North twenty five West sixty one poles to a stake pine and two others then South forty five West two hundred and fifty two poles to a stake pine two black Jacks and a Sunkin Oak and a horse Oak then South eighty West eighty two poles to a Post Oak near a branch in or near John Newby's Old Line then the course of said line South eleven East twenty poles to a corner then North twenty four East three hundred and fifty six poles together in George Jefferson's line then along his line North East one hundred and ten poles another amongst Pines then North eighty West East three hundred and three poles to a white Oak then North ten West twenty six poles to a cherry line amongst a stake white Oak and pine then along his line North forty eight West twenty one poles to a horse Oak then North thirty east ten poles to Newby's corner then along Newby's line South twenty West one hundred and eight poles to a red Oak then North twenty poles to the

beginning - as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the

said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *George Jefferson* -

and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *George Jefferson* -

shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson* - within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.

IN TESTIMONY whereof, we have caused our Great Seal to be hereunto affixed. WITNESS *RICHARD CASWELL*, Esquire, our Governor, Captain-General, and Commander in Chief, at *Kinston*, the *1st* Day of *September* - in the *1779* Year of our Independence, and in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty Nine -
