K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Green O. Bodinor*

have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Green O. Bodinor*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of

Bladen

*On the South side of the Great Marsh and on the West side
of Panters Branch near William Moores Line including
where he now lives Beginning at a Spanish Oak at the edge
of Panters Branch and Running West Twenty two Chains
Thirteen Links to a Stake then North forty four Chains and
Twenty three Links to a Stake then East Twenty two Chains
Thirteen Links to a Stake then South forty four Chains
Seventy three Links to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Green O. Bodinor his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

Green O. Bodinor shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
