

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *James Wright* have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *James Wright* a Tract of Land, containing

Two hundred and fifty Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson* South West of *Beeson* Old Mill Creek Beginning on John Persons thurs Corner Stake amongst three *White Oaks* three *Water Oaks* and a *Gum Oak* and runs thence South Eighty West four chains and fifty links to a stake two post Oaks and a pine in *James Wright's* line then with his line North thirty chains to a pine two *Black Oaks* and two post Oaks in the Old Mill Creek track of land then with that line South forty five East nine chains and fifty links to the corner Stake two *Hickories* and a pine then with that line North forty five East thirty one chains and sixty three links to a corner then North forty five West thirty one chains and sixty three links to a stake in the *White Oaks* then South forty five East eight and nine links to a *Black Oak* amongst four *Black Oaks* said to be John Persons corner then with his other line North forty five West twenty eight chains to a corner in said line then North eight East thirty nine chains to a corner then North sixty seven East twenty six chains to a corner at corner *William H. Langley* then South Eight West supposed to run with his line forty six chains to John Persons corner in said line then with *James Wright's* line South sixty seven West thirteen chains to his corner then with his other line South thirty five East fifty four chains and twenty three links to a stake amongst *Pines* then with the line of his other survey South forty East sixty three chains and sixty links to John Persons corner then with Persons line North fifty West fifty four chains and twenty three links to his corner then with his other line South forty West fifty four chains and twenty three links to Beginning by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land, belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *James Wright* his Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *James Wright* shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
