

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *Amos Clark* have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Amos Clark* a Tract of Land, containing *One hundred* Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

On the North East side of the Beaver Dam Swamp above the Main Road and including his Improvements where he now Lives Beginning at a Line on running West One hundred and Eighty Poles to a Stake, then North Ninety Poles to a Stake, then East One hundred and Eighty Poles, then South ninety Poles to the Beginning

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Amos Clark his Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

Amos Clark shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.

IN TESTIMONY whereof, we have caused our Great Seal to be hereunto affixed.
