come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Henry Taylor*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Henry Taylor*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred

Acres, lying and being in our County of

Bladen

*On the North East side of Downing Creek on the
South side of Jackson's Swamp beginning near the
Swamp at a Large Pine running Southwesterly
Pole to a Stake among Two Pines then East
One hundred and Eighty Poles to a Black Oak
and a Pine then North Ninety Poles to a Pine
then direct to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Henry Taylor his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

Henry Taylor shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
