

To all to whom these Presents shall
come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Hopkin Howell*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Hopkin Howell*
a Tract of Land, containing

Sixteen and three fourths
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*

*South West of Re Dee on the Long Branch Beginning at a
black Jack Archelus Moorman's third Corner by three Pines
and Runs thence South Seventy four East three Chains and
fifty Links to a Stake and three Pines then North twenty
five East forty eight Chains (losing a branch to a post
Jack Hickory and pine in Michael Moorman's line then
with his line North twenty four West three Chains and
fifty Links to a corner in said Moorman's line then with
his line South twenty five West forty eight Chains to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Hopkin
Howell* his Heirs and

Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Hopkin Howell*

shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*
Within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
