To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting.

**K**NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *Isaac Sims*, have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Isaac Sims*, a Tract of Land, containing

(One hundred and fifty) Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*, On the West side of Drowning Creek and on the South side of the Backs Swamp Beginning at a certain Pine above Abraham Barnes's Survey running North East Two West (One hundred and) Six Poles to a Lake and three Pines. Then North Twenty-eight East two hundred and Twenty Poles to a wall of Poles then South Sixty-two Poles East hundred and Six Poles to a Lake. Then to the Beginning South Twenty-eight West Six hundred and Twenty Poles

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

*Isaac Sims* his Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
