come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Isaham Sillman*

have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Isaham Sillman*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*Joining his own Back Line Beginning at a Pole on the
East side of a small Branch a Prong of the Great branch
and running along a part of a Line of a two hundred Acre
Tract North forty West One hundred and Twenty seven Poles
to a Pine in Hardy Sillmans Land then South forty West
One hundred and Twenty seven Poles to a Stake and two
Pines. thence South forty East One hundred and Twenty seven
Poles to his own corner thence along his old Line North
Fifty East One hundred and Twenty seven Poles to
the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Isaham Sillman his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

Isaham Sillman shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
