come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Jacob Blount*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Jacob Blount*
a Tract of Land, containing

Three hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*On the North side of Downing Creek and on both sides
of the Raft Swamp Beginning on the East side of said
Swamp at a Pine near the Swamp running South two
hundred and Ninety Poles to a Stake, then West two
hundred and Ninety Poles to a Stake, then North two
hundred and Ninety Poles to a Stake, then Direct
to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Jacob Blount his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Jacob Blount*
shall cause this Grant to

be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
