K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *James Council*

have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *James Council*

a Tract of Land, containing

Four hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of

Bladen

*Joining his own Land and James Gates Land and
John Kings Land and Argutons Willis Land Beginning
at a small Water Oak in Argutons Willis's upper Line
and running North forty five West three hundred and ten
Poles to a Stake, thence South forty five West two hundred and
forty Poles to a Stake, then South forty five East two hundred
and thirty Poles to a Stake, then North sixty three East
two hundred and fifty three Poles to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

James Council his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

James Council
shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
