into our Treasury by *James Brown*

have Given and Granted, and by these  
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *James Brown*  
a Tract of Land, containing

*One hundred*  
Acres, lying and being in our County of

*Bladen, In the County of*

*Cent to the sides of Jumping Run (Beginning at a Splinter  
in the edge of Warefords Swamp at the Mouth of Jumping  
Run and running North West One hundred and Twenty  
Poles to Richard Harrisons Line, then along his Line North  
Thirty four East One hundred and thirty four eight Poles to a Lightwood  
Swamp, thence South forty three East One hundred and twenty Poles to a  
Stakes, thence South thirty four West One hundred and thirty eight Poles to  
the Beginning)*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,  
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the  
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

*James Brown* his Heirs  
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money  
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may  
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *James Brown*

shall cause this Grant to be  
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*  
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise  
the same shall be void and of no Effect.

Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and *Twenty seven*.
