K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *James White*

have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *James White*
a Tract of Land, containing

Ninety
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*On the South side of South River Beginning at a Stake
on the River at the Point below Bakers Smelting and
Running South Twenty degrees West Ten Chains to a large
Cypress Tree and White Corners thence North thirty
Nine degrees West fifty eight Chains and fifty Links to
James Whites Line to a Pin on the said White's upper
Side, then North Twenty One degrees East Twenty Chains
to a Stake on the River thence the various Courses
of the River to the first Station*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

James White his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

James White shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
