come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *James Milkinson*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *James Milkinson*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*On the West side of Milkinsons Swamp, Beginning at a
White Oak, about 500 Yards East of the Cabin Branch
Running West One hundred Poles to a Maple in a small
Branch, then South One hundred and Sixty Poles to a
Stake among two Pines and Heavy Pointing, then East
One hundred Poles to a Stake, then Direct to the Beginning.*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

James Milkinson his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *James Milkinson*
shall cause this Grant to be

registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
