come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *John Andrews*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *John Andrews*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*On both sides of Gapway Beginning on the South side of
a Large Pine and running West Twenty two Chains and
Thirty six Links to a Large Pine, thence North forty four Chains
(and Seventy two Links to a Stake, thence East Twenty two Chains
(and thirty six Links to a Stake, thence South forty four Chains
and Seventy two Links to the Beginning)*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

John Andrews his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

John Andrews shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
