**K** NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of  
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid  
into our Treasury by *John Davis*  
have Given and Granted, and by these  
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *John Davis*  
a Tract of Land, containing  
*Three hundred and ninety* Acres,  
lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

On the South side of the North West River Beginning  
at the Mouth of Leawers Creek and running South  
Seventy two West four hundred and ten Poles  
to a Pine, then North fifty West two hundred and  
Forty Poles up Virginia Peters back Line  
thence North Seventy two East four hundred  
and fifty five Poles to the River thence  
down the various courses of said River  
to the Beginning

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,  
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the  
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

*John Davis* his Heirs and  
Alliages, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money  
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may  
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *John Davis*

shall cause this Grant to  
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*  
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise  
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
