KNOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *John Edge*, have Given and Granted and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *John Edge* a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*,

On the South side of Jones Creek including his Improvements Beginning at a Pine and Running South One hundred and Twenty Seven Poles to a Stake then East One hundred and Twenty Seven Poles to a Stake then North One hundred and Twenty Seven Poles to a Stake whence that One hundred and Twenty seven Poles is the Beginning

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

John Edge his Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *John Edge* shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our laid County of *Bladen* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
