To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *John Haymes* have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *John Haymes* a Tract of Land, containing

Two hundred Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*.

South West of Pa De on Gould fork of Brown Creek - Beginning at a Stake Powels third Corner and running with his line North forty chains to a stake in said line then West forty one chains and fifty Links to a Stake among of four Black Jacks, then South forty one chains to a corner then South Seventy five East thirty Eight chains to a corner at or near Dennis McIlensons line then North Sixty six East twenty seven chains to a corner in said Powels line then with his line West twenty chains to the Beginning.

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *John Haymes* his Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *John Haymes* shall cause this Grant to

be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
