K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *John James Senr*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *John James Senr*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*

*North East of Reddied on the Head of Light House Neck
Beginning at a pine by two pine pointers and Run
thence North thirty seven East thirty one Chain and Sixty
three Links to a stake and thence Black to a stake thence South
fifty three East thirty one Chain and Sixty three Links
to a stake and four pines then South thirty seven West thirty
one Chain and Sixty three Links to a stake then Black
to a stake and two pines then North fifty three West thirty
one Chain and Sixty three Links to the Beginning.*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *John*

James Senr his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *John James Senr*

shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
