Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid  
into our Treasury by *John Rimbrough*

have Given and Granted, and by these  
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *John Rimbrough*  
a Tract of Land, containing

*One hundred*  
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Amson*

*On Wilsons Creek of Little River Beginning at a point  
on or near Charles Smiths Line amongst three  
Red Oaks on the East side of said Creek and Running  
thence South forty East forty Chains down the course  
of the Creek to a corner then South fifty West twenty  
five Chains crossing the Creek to a corner then North  
forty West forty Chains to a corner then North fifty  
East twenty five Chains to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,  
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the  
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *John*

*Rimbrough* his Heirs  
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money  
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may  
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *John Rimbrough*

shall cause this Grant to be  
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Amson*  
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise  
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
