come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *John Linnon*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *John Linnon*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*On the North side of Bryers Swamp Including the
White Pond and Burbeys Improvement Beginning
at a small Pine and running North Seventy nine
East forty Chains to a Stake then South Eleven and
Twenty five Chains to a Stake then South Twenty nine
West forty Chains to a Stake then North Eleven and
Twenty five Chains to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

John Linnon his Heirs
and Affigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *John Linnon*

shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
