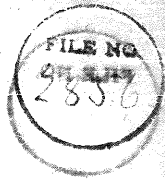


To all to whom these Presents shall
come, Greeting.



K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *John McFatter* have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *John McFatter* a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*.

On the Double Branch Beginning on the East side of the said Branch at a Pine and D. West Thirty one Chains and Sixty two Links to a Stake. thence D. South Thirty one Chains and Sixty two Links across the Double Branch to a Stake by a Pine. thence D. East thro' the said Branch thirty one Chains and Sixty two Links to a Stake, thence D. North thirty one Chains and Sixty two Links to the Beginning

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

John McFatter his Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *John McFatter* shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
