have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *John Hall*, a Tract of Land, containing

*One hundred* Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*

*North East of Puddled on the head of Light wood North*  
*Beginning at a pine a mound where and running thence*  
*North Eighty two East thirty Chains crossing the*  
*Charraw Road to a stake Central to two pines then*  
*South five East thirty three Chains and fifty Links*  
*to a corner then South Eighty five West thirty Chains*  
*crossing the Road to a corner then North five West*  
*thirty three Chains and fifty Links to the Beginning.*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *John Hall*

his Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *John Hall*

shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
