Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *John Hall*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *John Hall*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*

North East of Pied on the head of Light wood North
*Beginning at a pine amongd ^{pine} *Whew* and *Running* thence*
North Eighty five East thirty Chains crossing the
Charraw Road to a stake Central to two pines then
South five East thirty three Chains and fifty Links
To a corner then South Eighty five West thirty Chains
Crossing the Road to a corner then North five West
thirty three Chains and fifty Links to the Beginning.

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *John*
Hall his Heirs
and Assigns; for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *John Hall*

shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
