Fifty Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*.

South West of Peck's Dedon in the North Branch of Pinch Gulf Beginning at a hickory tree Red Oak and a post
Near Job Benton's third Corner and Running thence easterly
of his line South Twenty East crossing Mc Nitt's or
Thirty Chain to a stake and four Black Jacks then
South Twenty four East few Chains and fifty links
to a stake and find Dennis Mc Glendons corner then
his South Sixty one West Twenty Nine Chain to a corner then
North Twenty West Nineteen Chains and Seventy links
to a corner then North Seven East Twelve Chains to the
as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the

within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
